Greek Gods/Goddesses Business Card Research Project

Ancient Greeks believed that gods and goddesses ruled the world. They all had super-human powers. You will research a god/goddess and create a 5"x 8" sized business card to promote these special powers. You are to sell yourself as the god or goddess for the city-state of Chipmunklia.

A god or goddess will be randomly assigned to you. You will have two days in the library to conduct your research and three days in the library computer lab. You must use at least two books and one database source for your project. The books <u>must be</u> used before consulting electronic resources for facts about your god/goddess. Be certain to record where you obtained your information on your note cards. This will assist you in creating the works cited page.

- 1. The front of your business card must include the following:
 - Name of god or goddess
 - ❖ Special power(s)
 - Hand-drawn colorful image of god/goddess
 - Symbol(s)
 - * Address

- 2. The **back** of your business card must include the following:

 One or two well-developed paragraphs that include information about your god/goddess (Written in the first person.).
 - * Explain why we should elect you as our god/goddess.
 - * Explain the purpose of your existence.
 - Explain what you have done that proves yourself worthy.
- 3. Be ready to perform an oral presentation to the class whereby you must persuade our city-state of Chipmunklia to elect you as the god/goddess to worship. Feel free to dress up like your god/goddess; props may also be used to enhance your presentation. You may create a video recording of your presentation, but you will still need to answer questions from the audience.
- 4. Using the MLA format, create a works cited page and paper clip it to your business card.
