You will be researching a significant person in history based on the contribution he/she has provided society through acts of courage. Your research will be based on a person who has positively impacted our world today through their courageous acts. This assignment will be conducted in class and outside of school. You will be guided through the research process through several visits to the library. Using these skills you will generate a well-developed research paper. The guidelines are listed below.

- Minimum 2 typed pages
- Size 12 pt. font
- Font = New Times Roman
- 1.5 spaced lines
- Works-Cited Page in MLA Format (Noodle Tools)

Information to include in your essay:

- Introduction – *Set the purpose for the research* (claim)
- Background information – when and where was this person born, education, family, where did this person live, etc...
- Acts of Courage displayed by character and how they have impacted society, major accomplishments,
- Life changing events, challenges, little-known qualities, personal interest
- Closures – restate your claim, provide evidence

Oral Presentation Requirements:

You will be responsible for providing the class with a 1 minute speech about your person. You should include the main highlights of their life, accomplishments, and how they have displayed acts of courage. Use the information from your written report and put your speech on a note card that you can refer to while presenting. Practice your speech so you can have eye contact with the audience.
